<b>Map</b>	2018 by Nils-Göran Olsson following Map Standard ISOM2017.  Scale 1:10000, equidistance: 4 m.  DH45 och older and open classes: Scale 1:7500.
<b>Competition area and Terrain description</b>	Swedish League Elite 1-classes will compete on Skogsö, the peninsula between the coastal inlet Baggensfjärden and the narrow and shallow waters Baggensstäket, north of the railway. The terrain is typical to the archipelago, hilly and as this is close to the city, it has many tracks and other characteristics you find in recreation areas.  Backup area for Swedish League classes is Erstavik, south of the railway.  The spectator races and the sub classes E2-E3 will compete in Erstavik. This area offers flat, archipelago terrain full of details. The last part of the courses provides a shift in orienteering technique in fast urban terrain.
<b>Embargoed area</b>	The competition area is strictly embargoed and it is not allowed to visit the area until the competition is completed. Exception applies to Saltsjöbanan and highway Saltsjöbadsleden. See <a href="#">link</a> at the Eventor web site for details.
